History

HISTORY OF WARRIOR WIVES PRAYER MINISTRY (WAWPRAM)

§ DESCRIPTION –WHO WE ARE

WAWPRAM IS A NON-DENOMINATIONAL, non-profit group of married Christian women who come together, twice a month, on Sundays, with a commitment and zeal to pray, study Biblical principles of marriage and seek God's favour into our families. We do this with the hope of curbing divorce and broken homes in our society. We believe the weapons of prayer and knowledge are the secrets to successful divorce-proof marriages and strong families. The Bible declares in 2 Cor 10:4 that "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds". This is reflected in our slogan: Warrior Wives! – Prayer is Our Weapon!

§ THE REVELATION! THE IDEA!

WAWPRAM is a ministry birthed out of prayer and compassion to pray for healthy and strong Christian marriages. Mrs. Agnes Odoi had a burning heart to serve the Lord but did not know what the Lord wanted her to do. This dilemma of wanting to do something for God yet not knowing what exactly, caused her a lot of frustration to the point that she felt she was wasting her life. It was during her time in the Bible College that the Lord signaled/confirmed what He wanted her to do by using her as an instrument to resolve her colleague students' family challenges. Three years after Bible College she still did not know what the Lord had for her and so entered into intensive prayers and had the conviction that she had something in her hand. What vividly came into her mind was what she was doing with her colleague's families back in the Bible College. Sharing this vision with her husband Rev. Foster Odoi, she was encouraged to start immediately.

Mrs. Odoi after receiving a clear vision of what God has called her to accomplish and after receiving the total support of her husband made a move to initiate the ministry. She then shared this vision with some of her daughters in the Lord and the first person to share this vision with was Mrs. Mavis Karikari Amanfo who passed on last year. Thirteen women crystalized the inception

§ THE “VENUE” MOVEMENTS

The Home of Founders

The first meeting place for the thirteen wives was at the home of Rev. and Mrs. Odoi. Our second meeting saw eight (8) new wives being added to increase membership to twenty-one (21). The third meeting saw ten (10) wives in addition, increasing the membership to thirty-one (31). In the following meeting, twenty-three (23) wives were added which populated the membership to fifty-seven (57).

Mizpah School

The numerical growth necessitated relocation to Mizpah School (old site at Susanso) initially. Our first major program was held at Mizpah school which saw new members like Mrs. Evelyn Sarfo Adu Amankwah and Mrs. Ama Duncan joining the ministry. One interesting experience members will always remember about Mizpah School is the “wool dogs”. The ministry experienced a massive increase at Mizpah School but faced some challenges with residents of Mizpah School and so had to find a new meeting place.

Adum Presby JHS

From Mizpah School, the venue was moved to Adum Presby JHS by the able assistant of Mrs. Shirley Adom Appiah, but in less than two years the ministry had to find a new meeting place due to the inconveniences with respect to proximity and breaking of desks as a result of constant movement of the desks.

Grace Baptist School/Church

God opened a door for the ministry to meet in a three-classroom block at the Grace Baptist School, Amakom-Kumasi, through the initiatives of Rev. Justice Appiah Kubi and Rev. Robert Bob Asante. Grace Baptist School virtually became our home as a result of the kind reception the ministry received from the leadership of the church. It was the only place the ministry used as a venue for a longer period of time, for almost six years (6) and major activities were held there. The ministry also saw the tremendous impact and increase in membership and in the activities of Wawpram at this venue. Most of the members of Grace Baptist church became part of the ministry.

Amankwatia JHS Block B

From Grace Baptist Church the ministry moved to Amankwatia JHS in January 2017 to May 2018.

Current Meeting Place – Ojampah Hall

The ministry currently meets at the Ojampa Hall at Ayigya on the main Tech road, near the MTN office. The group meets fortnightly, and activities such as Bible Studies family seminars, retreats, counselling sessions and prayer meetings are organised towards achieving its vision. In addition, Pastor Mrs. Agnes Odoi hosts a programme on the Kumasi-based ‘Spirit’ 88.3 FM station every Wednesday from 3:00pm – 4:00 pm.

§ OUR COLOURS

Our colours are **orange** and **white**. The orange signifies energy in our lives, balance in our work and marriage, enthusiasm, warmth, vibrancy, optimism, flamboyance that permeates all aspects of our Christian lives as wives and mothers. Founder's Profile

REV. MRS. AGNES ODOI



Brilliant as she was, finances to take her through school were becoming more and more challenging, coupled with other challenges. After a one year break from school, she got admission at the Agona SDA Secondary School in Agona where she finally completed her secondary education; thanks to the determination and support of her single mother. All through her lifetime, Agnes never saw or experienced father-mother or husband-wife care and attention together. She was raised and nurtured by her single mother, Miss Rebecca Oppong.

REV. MRS. AGNES ODOI IS THE FOUNDER AND president of Wawpram. She is also a Lecturer at Ghana Baptist University College. Agnes grew up among two sisters and many cousins in the Ashanti regional capital, Kumasi. She started school at the Tafo Methodist Nursery in Kumasi, where her mum was teaching. She continued her primary school education at the St Benedict Primary school at Tafo Nhyiaeso, and she successfully completed her basic school education at the St Louis Demonstration JSS at Mbrom and enrolled in the Kumasi Girls Secondary School, at Old Tafo in Kumasi.

Agnes became born again through the Charismatic Evangelicals: a ministry dedicated to the rescuing of the youth for Christ. She grew in the Lord and got involved into full time ministry through the Charismatic Evangelicals. At this point, it appears her dreams of becoming a roman sister had weaned and a new passion of being a prolific all round teacher had started as she gained admission to the St Joseph's Training College at Bechem obtaining a Teacher Certificate A. After teaching for some time; Agnes begun to follow her first love for ministry. She began pursuing a Diploma in Biblical Studies and a Diploma in Theology with the Christian Service University



College. She proceeded to the University of Ghana – Legon; where she graduated with a Bachelor of Arts in Theology.

Agnes wasn't still satisfied with her academic laurels. She again went to the Kwame Nkrumah University of Science and Technology (KNUST) – School of Business to study a Master of Business Administration specializing in Human Resources Management.

She returned to the Christian Service University College to pursue a Master of Arts in Christian Ministry with Management. Currently, Agnes is a first-year postgraduate student in the speciality “Economics”, educational program “International Business Administration and Business Analytics” at the Department of Doctoral and Post-doctoral Studies of Sumy State University – Sumy in Ukraine.

Agnes met her husband Rev. Foster Odoi, a minister of God and a music minister, at an all-night service in 1995 and got married in 1997. She describes her husband as her other side, her best friend, support and prayer partner. “We’ve been very good friends ever since and have been the pillar behind each other. My husband is my encourager, my prayer partner and my partner in the ministry. He is my ‘other side,’” she says. Their 21 years of marriage is blessed with five children (three sons and two daughters). Their names should tell you what they do. Nathaniel, Praise, Worship, Thanks and

Melody are children of a singing mother and a Christian music director father making them “a highly musically inclined family.” Agnes Odoi explains, “All of us are ministry inclined, and each one has his or her own unique calling. As a family we believe in spending quality time together either at home, going out together or travelling to visit family friends. We treat everyone as special and have time to celebrate everyone’s birthday”.

‘As a family, we run a foundation that supplies second-hand clothing to the Northern part of Ghana, through the Bible Church of Africa in the Northern Region. This initiative began during one of our visits to a family friend in Yendi in the Northern Region. Praise our second son saw some children in town moving around without attire, panties or even slippers. He then asked me to tell the children to go and wear their dresses. I responded by telling him the children didn’t have anything to wear. This broke him down, and he started crying, and that was the beginning of the Praise Odoi’s foundation to the Northern part of Ghana in 2007. For now, we send items in bails quarterly to the Northern part of Ghana.

Agnes has a godly passion for marriage counselling and for helping couples stand through turbulent times capable of destabilizing marriages. She established the “Warrior

Wives Prayer Ministry” in 2008 where she is championing a crusade for fulfilling; successful, long-lasting marriages. The ministry now has five branches now in Kumasi, Sunyani, Accra, USA and UK.

She intimates, “The escalating rate of divorce and its consequences in our society became a burden on me, and so I started looking for solutions. My heart breaks when I hear about the challenges couples are facing in their marriages. I realized the role women have to play in this predicament. This desire gave birth to the vision to empower women locally and globally to have and enjoy successful long-lasting marriages, empower women to perform their God-given responsibilities as helpers to their husbands, to become good and responsible mothers to their children, and also to wage spiritual war against the devil to snatch our marriages, husbands, children and businesses through prayer and the study of the Word. Our ultimate is to make Heaven with our husbands and children. ‘I believe in family life building, and that woman as a whole has a unique calling in the world,’ she stated. ‘Marriage counselling is my hobby. I love listening to the challenges people are facing and offering godly counselling and supporting them in prayer to see them overcome those challenges,’ she said.

Her hobbies will definitely have cardinal among them, marriage counselling; she also loves cooking, singing, cleaning, reading and teaching.

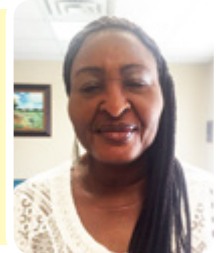

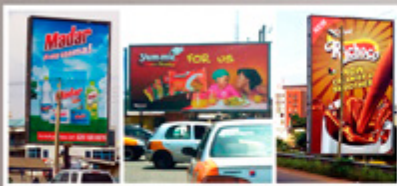

New Management

After a careful selection process amidst prayers and fasting, Warrior Wives Prayer Ministry was given the management of the Center. The ministry in its own volition after prayer decided to contribute a sum which is equivalent of 10% (a Tithe) of the agreed estimate of the major assets of the centre. This contribution was made to concretize Warrior Wives Prayer Ministry's partnership with Daniel's Christian Centre which is God's property. These contributions of 90% by God's servant and associates and 10% by Warrior Wives Prayer Ministry became a whole for God's work.

§ THE RADIO MINISTRY

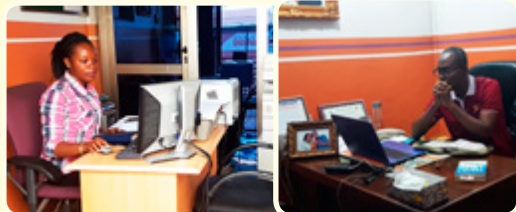
One of the biggest events that gives us the widest coverage is our radio broadcasting. The radio broadcasting has sent our messages to homes, towns and villages where we ourselves have not had the opportunity to be there. The impact of the radio ministry cannot be overemphasized. In spite of our financial limitations with regards to its sustainability and expansion, we continue to get/receive Macedonian calls both from the audience and media houses within and outside the Kumasi metropolis for us to air our messages. Even though it is hard work, we've been engaged in presenting live messages on some educative topics such as; The biblical Concept of Marriage; God's purpose for creation of wife; Male and Female He created them; The concept of Leaving, Cleaving and Becoming One flesh; The Concept of Love and Submission; Forgiveness in Marriage; Reconciliation, etc.

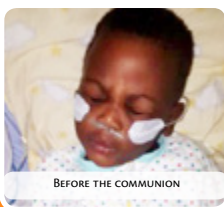

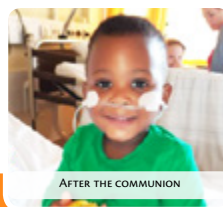

THE POWER OF GIVING

2 I'm Ama Duncan, Founder of The Fabulous Woman Network. I have been a member of the Warrior Wives Prayer Ministry since 2008. I didn't particularly join because I had a problem; I simply loved that I could pray along with other Christian women. Being a part of this ministry and having Rev. Mrs Agnes Odoi as my spiritual mother has been a

great blessing to me especially professionally. One important lesson I have learned here is to give and know that God will replenish in a thousand fold, literally. About 7 years ago I sowed a seed when my family needed a new place to rent, and God shocked us. On many other occasions, I sowed seeds – sometimes amounts that shocked even me – and

God totally flabbergasted me! Warrior Wives Prayer Ministry is the kind where we are taught to pray for ourselves, have crazy faith in Jesus, taught the word of God especially as married women and mothers, as well as given the opportunity to fellowship with women from all walks of life. I feel blessed to be part of this ministry.

3 I have been married for the past twenty-two years, however right through the first eighteen years, we experienced so many challenges that I did not enjoy any peace or happiness. After the first two years of marriage, my husband started having extra-marital

affairs. Sometimes he would inform me he was travelling to attend a two-week course in Accra, only to end up spending the entire period at another woman's house. Once I became aware of this, it degenerated into a huge fight on his return, during which I beat

him up mercilessly. None of this actually put an end to his affairs. At certain times I would show up at his girlfriend's house, lock them both in their rooms and beat them up, but all to no avail.

The last straw that broke the camel's back was when I

returned from my hometown earlier than planned and rang the bell. It was sometime before he answered the door, fuelling my suspicions that he was not alone in the house. I went straight to the bedroom which was empty, but I found the woman hiding in the bathroom. I was just about to hit her with a metal rod, but for the intervention of my husband who protected her with his hand. This resulted in an injury to his wrist and brought about a separation between us for about three months. Although we shared the same apartment and even the same bedroom, I used a separate bed and decided never to sleep in the same bed he had defiled with

another woman. None of these resulted in any change of behaviour or attitude. I lost all respect for him consequently; he became more recalcitrant as a result of my attitude towards him, turning all this into a very vicious cycle. The situation escalated to the point where I sought a divorce, but due to his status as an elder in his church, he brought in people I respected to plead on his behalf for reconciliation. Although I accepted his apology, I had lost all respect and love for him.

I was introduced to, joined WWPM at this point (2008), and through the teachings realised that fighting and naggings were futile and only

exacerbated the situation; the change had to start from within me. I also realised that I had contributed to the status quo through my own ignorance and insensitivity to his needs. My husband ultimately noticed this change and improvement in my relationship towards him, and consequently changed his own behaviour. One of the lessons I learnt was that nagging and fighting are marriage destroyers and do not serve any useful purpose in establishing happy and joyful marital homes. Now he advises and encourages others in similar situations using the example of our own experiences and the power of God to turn things around. Praise God!

I have not worked for two years because I wanted to take care of my kids for sometime. The beginning of this year my husband and I decided to send the kids to school so that I can work. On our prayer line, Mummy asked

us to sow any seed and add our declarations to it. I sowed the little money I had and sent my declaration and by God's grace we got a Christian School for my kids and the fees they were supposed to pay we were asked to pay half of it, on top of that

I had a job in the same school, so I still spend time with my kids even though they are in school. Two days after I started my Job my husband bought me a car. This can only be God. We indeed serve a God of miracle, signs and wonders.

5

I had been married for nearly five years but remained childless until just a year ago after I had been introduced to WWPM. We had several challenges in our marriage which usually worsened whenever I fell pregnant and subsequently miscarried. I found the situation so unbearable that I eventually left my marital home despite efforts by elders and church counsellors to resolve issues. We managed to come together after the miscarriage, but this was short-lived due to

misunderstandings and lack of affection for each other. I was pregnant at this point, but the frustration, worry and anxiety proved too much for me that I ended up in hospital. Concerned that I might lose this baby, I moved out of my home again and did not even return after the delivery, and did not see or speak to him for four years. I was so embittered I did not even want our child to sign his name as the father. She was due to start pre-school at Grace Baptist School, where I met

Pas. Mrs Odoi and through the discussion, I explained why I did not want my daughter signing her father's name, despite being the biological father. Mrs Odoi committed herself to counsel and praying with me to ensure the marriage worked again. My husband and I both realised how ignorant we had been, our marriage was restored by God's grace and we now share with and counsel others in similar situations. Glory be to God for resurrecting my marriage through this ministry.

I met my husband while he was a university student, we got married and afterwards went to Norway where he pursued further studies. We returned home after five years with our two children. Prior to his gaining employment, I worked as a seamstress to support our family, but then the challenges started. He began going after other women and would pretend to be attending a course for several days, only to be found spending the time with his girlfriend. After four years the woman eventually wanted to get out of the relationship, but my husband would not hear of it,

and the woman informed me to persuade my husband to leave her alone. We moved into our own home at this point, and I was introduced to WWPM. My husband started another affair with a university student and informed me he had to marry her as she had become pregnant. My knees went very weak at this news, and I nearly collapsed, I shed so many tears, became so depressed and lost so much weight I became ill. After she had her baby, he moved in to live with her, gave her his new car and took my old car away from me. I continued in prayer hoping the relationship would end. After a while they

started fighting, there was a lot of confusion between them, and the woman has now asked for a divorce.

My husband has now returned to us and apologised for his wrongs, and for the past year has been living at home. I also realised that fighting, nagging and anger only compounded issues. Through Mummy's teaching, encouragement and prayer support, I decided to carry out all my duties as a wife with patience. There is now a huge improvement, and I am trusting God to complete the good work He has started.

FRUIT OF THE WOMB

When my husband and I decided that we wanted a child we had it at the back of our minds that I should move from Accra where I was working to join him in Kumasi and have a job first, and we knew that God would help us to do this!! In March 2013, as a new member of WAWPRAM, a dear sister called to ask why she didn't see me at the WAWPRAM retreat (I didn't know about it). One day after the Groaning Women Prayer line, I decided to call mummy personality and tell her my problem. I was so happy that at long last I was going to be Mrs. Six months before his arrival, he sent money for the wedding preparations. I have learnt in life that in every situation it's better to talk to God rather than to talk to human beings. So I did not tell anybody about his coming,

and that was what really helped me from disgrace.

When he arrived, we came into a mutual agreement to part ways due to a health problem that he was battling with. So we end the relationship. I was devastated, heartbroken, and did not know where to start from. I felt so bad and rejected. As for this blow, I couldn't keep it to myself, so I informed a true friend of mine who is now in London about it.

She encouraged and advised me. She told me that there was a prayer fellowship called Warrior Wives Prayer Ministry. Coincidentally that day was a Sunday. The meeting was for married people, but although I was not married, she asked me to come with her to the meeting. I followed her to the meeting.

Just after the worship and praises, our Daddy pastor Odoi affectionately called

Darling Foster during ministration, prayed and told the congregation to also pray for me about my marriage. He said a lot to confirm what had just happened in my life. That day the presence of God was so strong in the meeting place, and I fell under the anointing severely. After the meeting, I saw that I was a little bit relieved. The sadness and the heaviness had gone a little. Aunt Nancy again took me to a retreat is for married women. When we got to the retreat, I told God that my being there was not a mistake or an accident and that I know he had something good in-store for me in that retreat. So I prayed, in fact, I really cried to God Almighty. Then our dear mummy (Servant Pastor Mrs. Agnes Odoi) asked us to write and bring our prayer request. I said to myself, "this is the moment of truth. I am going to dare God. I am going to write a daring prayer request". In my request, I told God to give me a husband, not just a husband but a loving and caring husband. I also requested that God should bless me in every aspect of life especially in the area of education. I wrote about five requests. I vividly recall these words "God I don't care how you are going to do it", and I added a seed offering to my request and I put it in an offering basket. These requests were made somewhere in 2008 when I was almost 32 years of age.

In 2009, to the glory of God:

- I first got married in 2009 and had a car
- Had a degree in 2009
- To crown it all, I was blessed with a bouncy baby in that same year –(2009)

In 2010 I got pregnant again, during the third trimester of the pregnancy I was lying down one evening doing a self-breast examination and found out that there was a mass (lump) in my breast. So the next day I called a doctor and told her what I had seen. She invited me over to the clinic, and she did the examination herself and confirmed that indeed there was a mass (lump). I immediately broke down in tears, because I knew how breast cancer was, family history also counts in this case because my elder sister died of breast cancer. To be honest with you I was really scared. I said to God minus me; I refused to have breast cancer in the name of Jesus. I was invited by the doctor for a series of test the next day. I left the hospital and drove straight to mummy's office at the Grace Baptist School and told her about my ordeal. Mummy told me it was nothing for the Lord was in control. We prayed, and I left. The following day I went to the hospital for the test, and the result came after a week and others took a month before the result was received. After the result, I was scheduled for surgery. I was very scared, so I called mummy and told her about it, and she prayed with me and told me again that the Lord was in control so I should not be afraid. After the surgery, the lump was taken for an investigation to ascertain whether it was cancer or not. Whiles, I was waiting for the result I was calling mummy to tell her I was scared about how the outcome would be and mummy would say, "Aunty whose report will make you believe? After one month of surgery, I went to the doctor's, and she said to me "congratulations madam". The investigations revealed that the mass (lump) was not what we thought it was. It was not cancer. I jumped and shouted "To God be the glory for great things he has done for me" God has really blessed me through this ministry. Today I am giving this testimony to glorify God and to encourage others that God is able. He is God of possibilities. God can do exceedingly and abundantly beyond what we can think of. People of God, prayer is the answer to every problem. If only you will believe He is God. God will do it for you just as He has done for me. He makes all things beautiful in His time. God has been so gracious unto me and unto my family, and now I'm blessed with three kids, a husband and my work. All that I'm saying is THANK YOU JESUS I will forever be grateful.
